Q: <u>Please confirm the contractor is allowed to release filtered water removed during the pipe</u> vacuuming process (known as "decant water") into the sanitary or storm system."

- 1. <u>If the decant water is to be released to the sanitary system, please confirm the sanitary sewer operator has granted permission.</u>
- 2. If the decant water is to be released to the storm system, please provide a copy of the MS4 permit.

A: Discharges to the Town's storm system are allowed, as long as they comply with the Town's General Bylaws, Chapter 171. Discharges to Storm Drain System and Chapter 174, Article VIII Discharge of Water onto a Public Way. A copy of the Town's bylaw is available on the Town's website.
