




Purpose of the Classification Hearing


The purpose of the Classification Hearing (Ch.40 §56) is to provide information so that the Selectmen can determine whether there should be a shift in the tax burden between property classes.


A shift in the tax burden does not change the total tax levy for the community; it simply determines the share to be borne by each class.


























Tax Relief Opportunities
