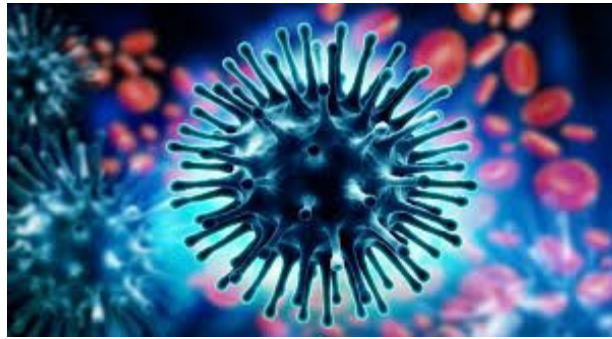


# BE A FIGHTER



## FIGHT THE FLU

Flu season is upon us and the Hopkinton Health Department has partnered with AFC Urgent Care of Natick and Marlborough to provide **two flu vaccination clinics** to the residents and employees of Hopkinton. The clinics will run from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the Crafts Room of the Senior Center located at 28 Mayhew Street, **on October 21, 2019. A second clinic will run at St. John's on October 25, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.**

Residents and employees **will need to bring your health insurance card with you!**

Participants are encouraged to pre-register utilizing the following web-form ([http://bit.ly/hopkinton\\_flu\\_clinic](http://bit.ly/hopkinton_flu_clinic)). Please note that there are separate tabs for each date and that we will be scheduling appointments in 5 minute increments. Volunteers will be present to assist with registration. A confirmation email will be sent to each on-line registrant. A consent form will be attached to the email. Participants are encouraged to print and complete the attached consent form. Please bring the completed form to your appointment.

**As an incentive to promote flu vaccination**, participants attending the clinic will be eligible to receive a \$10 gift card to Apex Entertainment.

**If you cannot attend the clinic**, you are welcome to visit AFC's Natick or Marlborough location at any time during business hours to receive a flu shot. Once again, bring your insurance card. You can also see your primary care physician or another local pharmacy providing flu shots.
